



The Navajo Tribal Utility Authority awards scholarships and internships to Navajo students pursuing higher education in programs of study related to the multi-service utility industry, such as business, accounting, engineering (electrical, civil, or environmental), chemistry, computer science, or information technology. The program supports Navajos in obtaining bachelors and master’s degrees that will lead to higher-quality job opportunities and self-sufficiency.
